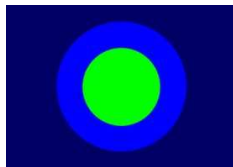

Statute of The World Party Nepal (WPN)

Preamble

Nepal – a predominantly mountainous, agricultural and rural developing country of Asia – has always been a sovereign nation, never ruled by any colonial powers. The country lies between its two large neighbours – China in the north and India on south, east and west. A member of the United Nations right from 1956, it is also widely known for its very brave and friendly people bestowed with the pride of being the citizens of the country that is the birthplace of the Buddha – revered across all parts of the worlds as the Apostle of Peace and the Light of Asia. Nepal is specially gifted by nature also in the sense that among the 14 highest mountains (over 8,000m) of the world, eight, including the highest (8,848.86m) peak the Sagarmatha (also known as Mt. Everest), fall in Nepal. The country is endowed with an extremely rich biological diversity, natural beauty and cultural heritage.

Abiding by the ancient precept and practice of *Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam* (Skt., = The world is a family), we wish to make contribution in efforts towards alleviating conflicts, crimes and chaos of various manifestations and to fostering fraternity, compassion, cooperation/collaboration among all individuals, communities and societies not only within the country but also in the entire world. We are also sincerely committed to striving to succeed in meeting the global Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), 2016-2030. This can be best achieved through attainment of comprehensive, coherent and complete peace, progress and prosperity at all places and for all people. For this reason, formation and functioning of a well-organized and well-intentioned World Federation of world citizens is deemed most essential to see all that happen in a relatively reasonably short span of time. This realization has led to the creation of the World Party, which is rapidly gaining momentum in its organizational structure and professional activities. As one of its fellow organizations, we hereby establish the World Party Nepal (WPN) in our country Nepal.

The WPN Statute Articles

Article 1: Name of the Organization

The name of this party shall be World Party Nepal, abbreviated as WPN.

Article 2: Location of the WPN Office

The Head Office of the WPN shall be located at Ekantakuna, Lalitpur Metropolitan City, Kathmandu Valley, Nepal. [The exact address would be mentioned once we obtain/rent-in our office space/building/rooms.] The WPN Central Committee (WPNCC) can shift the office location and change the address in case there is a justifiable need to do so. The WPN may also gradually set up its Branch Offices at various suitable locations in the country when recommended and approved by the WPNCC.

Article 3: WPN Policy

The fundamental policy of the WPN is to work for the overall well-being of the people of Nepal in particular and the world community in general, and for that to contribute in establishing the World Federation (WF).

Article 4: WPN Undertakings

The WPN shall carry out the following key undertakings to achieve the overall objective stated in the preceding article:

1. To uphold the Constitution of Nepal;
2. To work for the overall wellbeing of the people of Nepal;
3. To devote to international fraternity, peace, progress and prosperity; and
4. To participate actively in the process of establishing the World Federation.

Article 5: WPN Membership

1. The WPN shall recognize a person as its Regular Member (RM) who is aged 18 years or above, has accepted the objectives and principle of this Party, and agreed to pay the annual membership fee of NRs.1000 on a timely basis.
2. A member who did not pay the membership fee for one year or more and a member who has got registered without paying the membership fee shall be considered only a supporting member and shall not have the right of the regular member. While the regular member shall have the right to speak and to vote in the WPN Convention (WPNC) and the WPN Extraordinary Convention (WPNEC) and may become an Executive Member (EP) of the Party, the supporting member may attend the

Convention but shall have no right to speak and to vote and may not become an Executive Member (EM).

Article 6: WPN Convention

1. The WPN Convention shall be the supreme legislative organ of the WPN and shall discuss and decide on the following issues:
 - i. Adoption and amendment of this Statute;
 - ii. Approval of settlement of accounts and budget bill;
 - iii. Report on the result of undertakings and approval of plan of action;
 - iv. Election of the President and the Central Committee Members (CCMs);
 - v. Admission of new member and dismissal of member who is unsuitable for the Party; and
 - vi. Other issues as deemed relevant by the Convention.
2. The Convention shall be held once a year as decided by the Central Committee of the WPN.
3. The Convention shall be approved regardless of the number of attending members as far as the notice of the Convention had been issued by the President through the ordinary or electric mail or on the Internet at least one month before the date of opening and the venue is not difficult to access as compared with other venues.
4. All matters in the Convention, except for those stipulated in this Statute, shall be decided by more than half of the members present, and in case of a tie, the President shall decide on the matter.

Article 7: WPN Extraordinary Convention

1. The WPN Extraordinary Convention (WPNEC) shall be convoked when one of the following conditions is fulfilled and shall become the supreme legislative organ of the World Party Nepal (WPN):
 - i. When the President judged that the Extraordinary Convention is necessary;
 - ii. When more than 30 percent of the members of the WPN required it; and
 - iii. When more than 30 percent of the office branches required it.

When one of the above conditions is fulfilled, the President shall hold the Convention within one month.

2. The Convention shall be approved regardless of the number of attending members as far as the notice of holding the Convention had been issued by the President through the ordinary or electric mail or on the Internet at

least 10 days before the date of opening and the venue is not difficult to access as compared with other venues.

3. All matters in the Convention, except for those stipulated in this statute, shall be decided by more than half of the members present, and in case of a tie, the Chief Election Commissioner shall decide on the matter.

Article 8: International Secretariat

While the World Party and the World Party Nepal are legally independent organizations, by virtue of being a country chapter of the former the World Party Nepal accepts the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the World Party. This MOU is a completely informal proceeding and not binding upon the law.

Article 9: WPN President

The President of WPN shall be elected from among candidates in the World Party Nepal Convention. The term of office of the President shall be four years, and the President cannot be elected for more than two consecutive terms. It means that the current President can be a candidate in upcoming election as President, but cannot be a candidate after completion of her/his two terms. However, he/she may be given the respectable position of an adviser upon completion of her/his term/s of office as the President.

Article 10: WPN Central Committee

The WPN Central Committee is composed of the President, the Vice President, the General Secretary, the Joint Secretary, the Joint Secretary, the Public Relation Officer, and the Office Secretary. All of the Central Committee members will be elected by direct election. However, the first President of the WPN will be selected by the President of the World Party. Subsequently, the WPN President shall appoint rest of the first Central Committee members. He/she may also appoint additional executive members other than the ones stated above, for such positions as Directors where deemed necessary. The maximum number of such position holders shall be 12. The President shall be entitled to also remove any of the executive members when he/she deems it necessary.

The term of office of any member in the Central Committee shall be four years, and no member can be elected for more than two consecutive terms. It means that the current member can be a candidate in upcoming election as a member or for any other position. However, he/she cannot be a candidate for any Central Committee position after completion of her/his two terms.

Article 11: Functions of the WPN Central Committee

1. The President shall represent the World Party Nepal (WPN), convoke the WPN Convention, the WPN Extraordinary Convention, and the Board of Central Committee, and shall become the Chairperson of the sessions.
2. The Vice President shall assist the President, and when the President cannot perform her or his functions due to some reasons, the Vice President (VP) shall deputize for the President. When the President has resigned or passed away, the Vice President shall become the President. The term of office shall be remaining term of the former President.
3. The General Secretary (GS), by command of the President, shall issue instructions to the Joint Secretary and support staff to carry out her/his functions. The Joint Secretary General (JS) shall support the GS and perform the latter's duties in the latter's absence.
4. The Treasurer shall deal with the income and expenditure related matters of the WPN.
5. The Public Relations Officer (PRO) shall announce the official statements of the WPN.
6. The Office Secretary (OS) shall maintain all official activities as per the instructions of the President and/or the Secretary General.

Article 12: Board of the WPN Central Committee

1. The Board of WPN Central Committee shall be composed of the President, the Vice President, the General Secretary, the Joint Secretary, the Treasurer, the Public Relations Officer, and the Office Secretary. It shall be convoked by the President and shall discuss and decide on such issues as the venue and the date of the WPN Convention and the WPN Extraordinary Convention, the budget bill, and other necessary matters. All matters shall be approved by the WPN Convention or the WPN Extraordinary Convention.
2. The resolution shall be valid if more than half of the WPN Central Committee members are present. Or, the resolution shall be valid regardless of the number of attending Central Committee members as far as the notice of the Board of Central Committee had been issued by the President through the ordinary letter, or the electric mail, or the Internet at least one month prior to the date of opening and the venue is not difficult to access as compared with other venues.
3. All matters in the Board shall be decided by more than half of Central Committee present, and in case of a tie, the presiding officer shall decide the matter.

Article 13: WPN Office Branches and Members

1. WPN can open its branch office in the headquarters of each of the seven provinces and seventy-seven districts as and when the WPN Central Committee deems it necessary and practically possible. A new branch office shall be opened as far as the WPN Convention agreed and authorized it. A new branch office shall be refused or existing branch shall be dismissed when the Convention resolved that the branch is inappropriate or unnecessary for the World Party Nepal. The headquarters of the WPN shall have its members and the branches too shall have their members. When there is no branch in a province and district, members from that province or district shall be registered as members at the WPN headquarters.
2. The qualification of the member at the headquarters shall be specified by this statute, and the qualification of the member of each branch shall be specified by the Central Committee. New members at the headquarter shall be, as far as there is no particular objection, authorized without condition by the Convention. An applicant for joining the WPN shall be refused or current members shall be dismissed when the Convention resolved that they are inappropriate for the Party. Each branch can accept new members and dismiss inappropriate members following the decision of the Central Committee. However, the Convention also can dismiss the members of each branch by its resolution.
3. Members at the headquarters shall pay the party membership fee to the headquarters office and members at each branch shall pay the party membership fee to the branch office. Each branch shall pay 40 percent of its revenue to the headquarters office as the party fee. The amount of fee that the members of the headquarters and of the branch/branches pay shall be decided by the Convention.

Article 14: Impeachment

1. In the WPN Convention and the WPN Extraordinary Convention, the President shall be removed if two-thirds or more of the members present resolved on the removal of the President. When the President has been removed, new president shall be elected within 40 days. In this case, the process of election is commanded by the Election Commission (EC).
2. The Central Committee other than the President may also be removed with impeachment supported by a two-third majority. When the Central Committee other than the President has been removed, the President may appoint new members of a different Central Committee until the next election.

Article 15: Vote of a Member

In the WPN Convention and the WPN Extraordinary Convention, each member shall have one vote. The vote may not be entrusted to another member.

Article 16: Budget and Assets

The WPN sources of budget and assets shall be composed of the party membership fee and donations. The Fiscal Year (FY) is from 1st January to 31st December.

Article 17: Delegation of Decision

Matters not stipulated in this Statute shall be decided by the Board of Central Committee (BCC).

Article 18: Election Commission

The Election Commission (EC) will be consisted of one Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) and two Election Commissioners (ECs). No member of the EC can be a candidate of that election where s/he is appointed as the CEC or the EC. The Central Committee will deal the appointment of the Election Commission who will hold the election in a free, fair and impartial manner.

Article 19 Enforcement

This Statute shall be enforced from 28 February 2021.
